Birch—Paper, Yellow and River (a “near-native”)

Box Elder (which some consider a weed)

Cherries—Pin, Black and Chokecherry

Pagoda Dogwood

Hackberry is GREAT—but not really native in Vilas County

Hawthorns—various species

Maples—Mountain, Red, Silver and Sugar

Oaks—Bur, Northern Pin, Red (Swamp White Oak is good in low areas, but not really a Vilas County plant again)

Serviceberry—Alleghany and Juneberry

Balsam Fir

Pines—Jack, Red and White

Spruce—White and Black

Creeping Juniper—native to Door County

Dwarf Birch

Wild Blackberry

Lowbush Blueberry

Sand Cherries—*Prunus pumila* and *besseyii* (both “near-natives”)

Viburnums—Highbush American, Downy, Maple-leaved, Nannyberry

Winterberry

Wild Grape

Englemann Ivy

Woodbine
