A RAIN GARDEN GATHERS RUNOFF FROM ROOFTOPS, DRIVEWAYS AND LAWNS. THIS WATER OFTEN CARRIES POLLUTANTS. INSTEAD OF THE RUNOFF GOING INTO THE STORM SEWER OR INTO LAKES AND STREAMS, IT CAN BE DIVERTED TO A SHALLOW DEPRESSION (THE RAIN GARDEN.) HERE THE WATER IS CONTAINED AND FILTERED THROUGH THE ROOTS OF THE RAIN GARDEN PLANTS AND THE SOIL OF THE RAIN GARDEN, EFFECTIVELY REMOVING POLLUTANTS AND REPLENISHING OUR GROUND WATER SUPPLY.

PLANT A RAIN GARDEN AND YOU WILL:

- 1) REPLENISH THE GROUNDWATER SUPPLY
- 2) REMOVE POLLUTANTS
- 3) ADD BEAUTY TO YOUR SURROUNDINGS
- 4) CREATE HABITAT FOR BIRDS AND BUTTERFLIES
- 5) PROTECT LAKES AND STREAMS FROM EROSION AND NUTRIENT LOADING
- 6) LESSEN DISCHARGE INTO WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANTS

LOCATE YOUR NORTHERN RAIN GARDEN ON A SLIGHT SLOPE AT LEAST TWENTY FEET FROM YOUR BUILDING FOUNDATIONS. SIZE SHOULD BE A SHALLOW DEPRESSION 4 TO 12 INCHES DEEP OVER AN AREA 20% THE SIZE OF THE HARD SURFACE BEING DRAINED FOR SANDY/ LOAMY SOILS, OR 40% FOR CLAY SOILS. ANOTHER WAY TO FIGURE OUT GARDEN CAPACITY IS BY THE NUMBER OF PLANTS, BASED ON ONE PLANT FOR EVERY 1 SQUARE FOOT OF RAIN GARDEN AREA. FIGURE ON USING PLANTS AT 1-FT. SPACING - EXCEPT FOR SHRUBS OR OTHER LARGE PLANTS.

SANDY AREA - USE 1 PLANT FOR APPROX. EVERY 5 SQUARE FEET OF ROOF AREA LOAM SOIL - USE 1 PLANT FOR APPROX. EVERY 3 SQUARE FEET OF ROOF AREA CLAY SOIL - USE 1 PLANT FOR APPROX. EVERY 2 SQUARE FEET OF ROOF AREA
