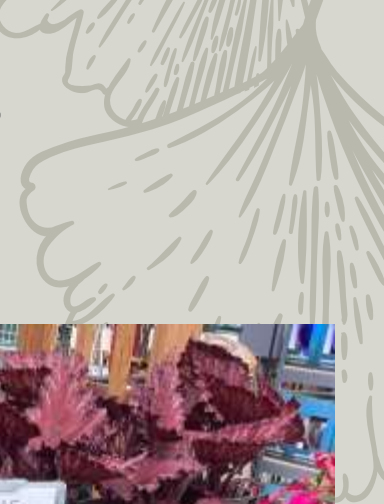

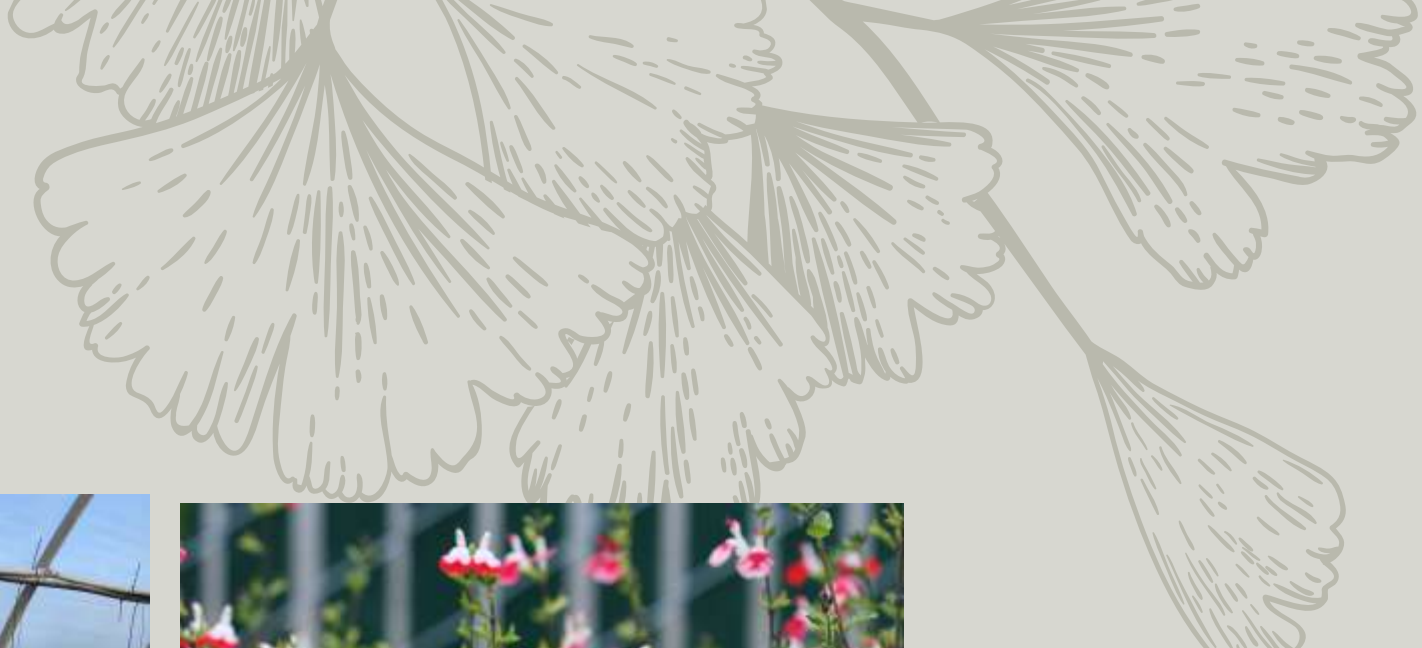

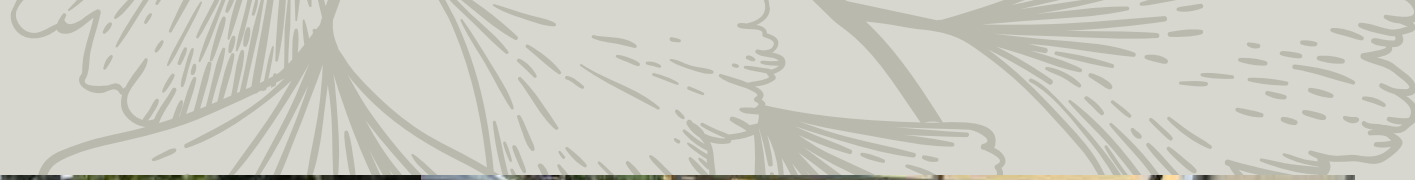


Sweet Potato Vine

Verbena bonariensis Meteor Shower



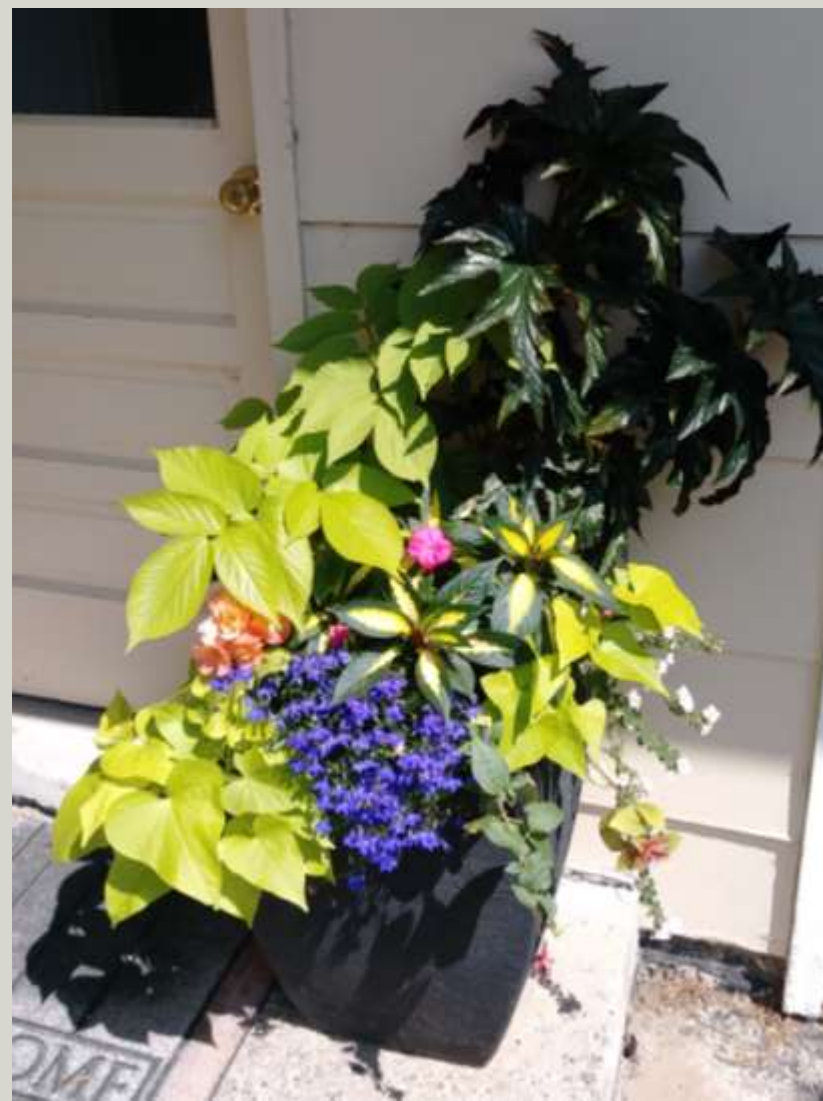

Aconitum - Monkshood



- **Last blooming plant in the garden**
- **Deer resistant**
- **Toxic**

Alchemilla – Lady's Mantle



- **Foliage**
- **Deer resistant**
- **Low maintenance**
- **Groundcover**

Allium – Ornamental Onion



- **Deer resistant!**
- **Great for Bees**
- **Unique globe shaped flowers**
- **Super tough**
- **Many varieties: Globemaster, Millenium, Blue Eddy, New Walters varieties**

Aralia Sun King - Spikenard



- **Bright foliage for shade**
- **Deer resistant**
- **Shrub-like**
- **Perennial Plant of the Year 2020**

Aruncus Misty Lace - Goatsbeard



- **Low Maintenance and Tidy**
- **Unique Airy Flowers**
- **Shade to Sun**
- **Deer resistant**

Chelone Hot Lips - Turtlehead



- **Late bloomer**
- **Easy to grow**
- **Tolerates wet places**
- **Unique flower shape**
- **Colonizes but tidy**



Cimicifuga - Bugbane



- **Dark Leaved or Native Green**
- **Bottlebrush Flowers**
- **Shady, Woodland Locations**
- **Deer Resistant**



Echinops Blue Glow – Globe Thistle



- **Bright blue globe-shaped flowers (Dr. Suess plant)**
- **Dry spots**
- **Sun lover**
- **Great for Pollinators**

Hellebores – Lenten Flower



- **One of most deer resistant plants**
- **Shade lover**
- **Earliest bloomer**
- **Many unique colors**



Hemerocallis Ruby Spider - Daylily



- **Huge Flowers**
- **Low Maintenance**
- **Tough Plants**



Hosta



- **Fried Bananas**
- **Party Streamers**
- **Wheee!**

Nepeta - Catmint



- **Longest Blooming Perennial**
- **Adaptable**
- **Great for Pollinators**
- **Deer Resistant**

Peonies



- Deer Resistant
- Showstopper
- Short Bloom Time



Penstemon - Beardtongue



- **Great Dark Foliage Color**
- **Long Blooms**
- **Great for Pollinators**

Salvia Marvel Rose



- **Deer Resistant**
- **Long and Repeat Bloomer**
- **Low Maintenance**
- **Best on the Market**



Thalictrum - Meadowrue



- Woodland Plant
- Tall to Medium Heights that Rise Above Other Plants



Molinia Skyracer Grass



- **Great substitute for “Pampas Grass”**
- **Tall, Fast Growing**
- **Showstopper**
- **Winter Interest**



Native Perennial Plants –

Plants that come up every year and are naturally found in our region



Asclepias tuberosa - Butterflyweed



- **Great Orange Flower**
- **Sandy, Dry Conditions**
- **Full Sun**
- **Great for Pollinators**



Eryngium yuccafolium – Rattlesnake Master



- **Mid-Height Prairie Plant**
- **Unique Globe-shaped Flowers**
- **Pollinators**

Geum triflorum – Prairie Smoke



- **Low Growing Groundcover**
- **Early Bloomer**
- **Unique Smoke-like Seedheads**
- **Great for Bees**

Liatriis spp. - Blazingstar



- **Mid-Height Grower in Medium Conditions**
- **Full Sun**
- **Great for Pollinators**

Lobelia cardinalis – Cardinal Flower



- Full Sun
- Moist Areas
- Can Be Short Lived



Monarda fistulosa – Wild Beebalm



- **Long Bloomer**
- **Bee Magnet**
- **Easy to Grow**

Silphium spp. – Cup Plant & Compass Plant



- Tall!
- Unique Attributes
- Great for Birds

Mertensia virginica – Virginia Bluebells



- **Spring Ephemeral**
- **Early Bloomer**
- **Beautiful Flowers**

Solidago speciosa – Showy Goldenrod



- Last Food Source For Monarchs
- Does Not Cause Hay Fever

Sporobolus heterolepsis – Prairie Dropseed Grass



- **Low Mound with Taller Seedheads**
- **Warm Season Grower**
