

HANSON'S GARDEN VILLAGE HYDRANGEA LIST 2023

Annabelle: Hydrangea arborescens 'Annabelle'

Height: 4-5' Width: 3-5' Part Sun to Shade Zone 3 White Flowers
Annabelle is a smooth hydrangea cultivar which features much larger flowers than the species. Large
white flowers appear in symmetrical, rounded heads. Blooms by late June into September, sometimes with
a small repeat bloom in the fall. It often takes a number of years to attain full flowering. Early blooming
stage may have a greenish cast or mature into a greenish cast. Thrives in shade. Tolerates full sun only if
grown with consistent moisture. Best to trim to within 10" of the soil in late fall. Blooms off of new wood.

Incrediball®: *Hydrangea arborescens* 'Abetwo'

Height: 4-5' Width: 4-5' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 White Flowers A superb improvement, with giant blooms that have roughly 4 times as many flowers as 'Annabelle'. The show begins in midsummer with huge round blooms clustered atop sturdy branches that are surrounded by medium green oval leaves. Cut back in spring to promote flowering on summer wood. Fantastic as a specimen shrub or in a border.

Invincibelle® Spirit II: Hydrangea arborescens 'NCHA2'

Height: 3-5' Width: 3-4' Part Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 Pink Flowers Proven Winners®. This new and improved Invincibelle® Spirit Hydrangea delivers on all accounts. It has darker foliage, stiffer stems, and larger flowers that are a richer pink that ages to an attractive green. Blooms from mid-summer to frost. It is a strong re-bloomer.

PANICULATA TYPES ORDERED BY HEIGHT (SHORT TO TALL)

Bobo®: *Hydrangea paniculata* 'ILVOBO'

Height: 2½-3' Width: 3-4' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 White Flowers Proven Winners®. This dwarf hydrangea will turn heads! Bobo® is engulfed by large white flowers in summer that can turn pink in the fall. This new early blooming variety has blooms that are held upright on strong stems. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

Little Quick Fire®: *Hydrangea paniculata* 'SMHPLQF'

Height: 3-5' Width: 4-7' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 White to Pink Flowers Proven Winners®. Like Quick Fire®, it is early blooming, flowering about a month before other Hydrangeas. White flowers transform to pink-red as summer progresses. This dwarf plant fits easily into any landscape.

Little LimeTM: hydrangea paniculata 'Jane'

Height: 3-5' Width: 3-5' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 Lime Green to Pink Flowers Proven Winners®. A dwarf form of the extremely popular 'Limelight' hydrangea, Little LimeTM has the same great flowers but is about a third the size of the original. Large cone-shaped flowers emerge lime-green, but mature to pink in the fall. Flowers typically bloom from July through September. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

Little Hottie®: Hydrangea paniculata 'Bailpanone'

Height: 3-5" Width: 3-5" Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 White Flowers An exciting new compact panicle hydrangea introduction, Little Hottie has very full flower heads with florets that emerge green and turn sparkling white. This well-branched, compact panicle hydrangea is covered in large blooms from the bottom to the top of the plant and holds tight flower clusters out on strong stems. Bred for heat tolerance, flowers don't get heat-stressed or turn brown in excessive heat. With natural basal branching, this new introduction doesn't need much pruning in production or the landscape to grow into a well-shaped plant with strong stems. Fall color is soft pink.

Diamond Rouge®: Hydrangea paniculata 'Rendia'

Height: 4-5" Width: 3-4' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 White to Purple-Red Flowers This variety has abundant, long lasting, rounded flower heads that start white and progress to pink, intense raspberry red and finally wine red. Flowers start blooming in July and take on red coloration earlier in the season than other pink paniculatas. Flower color is best in the fall when night temperatures are 10 degrees cooler than day temperatures. Compared to Strawberry Sundae®, Diamond Rouge® is slightly bigger and has distinct raspberry-red flowers that color earlier in the season.

Limelight Prime[™]: *Hydrangea paniculata* 'SMNHPPH'

Height: 4-6' Width: 4-5' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 Lime Green to Pink Flowers An improved, more refined Limelight with darker, healthier-looking foliage, stronger stems, and a more compact growth habit. The blooms emerge a vivid lime green and maintain that color longer, often until they transition into a bubblegum pink. The blooms eventually finish a rich, punch pink. It makes a better-looking container, and finishes just as quickly as 'Limelight'.

Tickled Pink®: Hydrangea paniculata 'HYPMAD II'

Height: 4-5' Width: 5-6' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 4 White to Pink Flowers First Editions®. You'll be tickled pink by the flowers on this hydrangea. Each bloom is covered by recurving flower petals that give the large blossoms a lacy appearance. The blooms begin white before turning rosy pink. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

Strawberry SundaeTM: Hydrangea paniculata 'Rensun'

Height: 4-5' Width: 3-4' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 4 White/Pink Bicolor to Red Flowers First Editions®. Strawberry SundaeTM is a delicious new compact hydrangea. Similar in many ways to Vanilla StrawberryTM with one important exception, its smaller stature. Flowers emerge creamy white in midsummer, change to pink and finally to strawberry red. The flowers will remind you of a refreshing strawberry sundae ice cream treat on a hot summer afternoon. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

White Diamonds®: Hydrangea paniculata 'HYPMAD I'

Height: 4-6' Width: 5' Full Sun to Part Sun Zone 4 White to Light Pink Flowers First Editions®. White Diamonds® is an exceptional new compact hydrangea with glistening white blossoms in mid summer that eventually fade to pink in the fall. Smaller and more manageable than most Hydrangea paniculata, White Diamonds® boasts increased heat and drought tolerance on a plant with dense growth. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

Berry White®: Hydrangea paniculata 'Renba'

Height: 6-7' Width: 4-5' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 White/Pink Bicolor to Red With strong, upright stems and large cone-shaped flower panicles that stay upright, this plant is a summer stunner. The flower color starts out white in July then progresses to dark pink. Coloring occurs from the bottom and progresses to the top of the panicle. Berry White® blooms a little later than Strawberry Sundae® and about the same time as Vanilla StrawberryTM

Vanilla StrawberryTM: Hydrangea paniculata 'Renhy'

Height: 6-7' Width: 4-5' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 4 White/Pink Bicolor to Red Flowers First Editions®. A delicious new hydrangea with enormous flowers that are a blend of vanilla and strawberry. Blossoms emerge creamy white in mid summer, change to pink and finally to strawberry red. New blooms gives the plant a multicolored effect in late summer and early fall. The red color can last for 3-4 weeks. Upright habit becoming cascading later in the season. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

Quick Fire®: Hydrangea paniculata 'Bulk'

Height: 6-8' Width: 6-8' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 4 White to Pink Flowers Proven Winners®. Quick to bloom, a month earlier than other varieties (sometime in June). The stiff, upright flowers begin to turn deep pink before most hydrangeas even begin to show flowers. A terrific way to extend the hydrangea season. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring.

Limelight: *Hydrangea paniculata* 'Limelight'

Height: 6-8' Width: 5-7' Full Sun to Part Shade Zone 3 Lime Green to Pink Flowers Proven Winners®. Popular variety of Hydrangea paniculata that boasts very large cone-shaped flowers. Limegreen flowers bloom in mid summer and eventually turn pink in fall. Blooms off of new wood. Can prune anytime after fall frosts up until new growth starts in spring. This is a vigorous grower.
