The retail season kicks off in February with bare root pre-orders and moss basket class sign-ups - and we know some of you have been waiting - so get all the details below!

With our POS system upgrade we have been busy getting a new online shopping site ready for our customers. This will allow online bare root ordering!!! And a new way to book our classes! We will also be able to synchronize in-store and online sales, process cards when the internet is down and offer more checkout options for days when the lines are out the doors.

We are also transitioning to e-gift and gift cards. Gift cards will be available in-store later this month, or [you can purchase an e-gift card here!](#) E-gift cards are sent to you or the recipient via email and presented on a phone at the checkout for redemption.

Sales of our paper gift certificates will be phased out by March 2026, however, we will still accept them at checkout until they are gone. We will continue selling paper gift certificates until our new

2026 Bare Root Pre-Ordering Now Available!

WHY BUY BARE ROOT?

- Cheaper than potted
- Huge selection of trees, shrubs and fruits
- Some varieties only available as bare root
 - Easier to transport
 - Easier to plant
- Can be planted ASAP
- Comes with a guarantee

Bare root plants are sold dormant with the roots exposed (not potted) and must be kept moist until planting occurs. Because of the nature of bare root plants, they are only available in the early spring and can sell out quickly.

We are now taking pre-orders for bare root trees and shrubs!
Pre-orders will be accepted through Monday, April 20th, 2026.

No orders will be taken Tuesday, April 21st - Friday, April 24th in order to give our staff time to pull pre-orders and set up for in-store sales.

Bare root must be paid for, in full, at the time of order. Customers with pre-orders will be allowed to pick up their orders a day before our in-store sale starts - Friday, April 24th - however, no new or additional purchases of bare root plant material will be allowed until Saturday, April 25th. Pre-orders can be held for about a week.

In-Store Bare Root Sales Start Saturday, April 25th

Any plants that are not pre-sold will be available in-store beginning on Saturday, April 25th through approximately May 8th, 2026 (weather permitting).

Phone orders to hold remaining bare root will be accepted again starting on Saturday, April 25th once the in-store sales begin.

Bare Root Information

- Dormant bare root plant material is a very successful, inexpensive way to plant, however it is only available during a short window in the spring. You must be ready to pick up your selections and plant them as soon as possible after you take charge of them. Planting can happen as soon as you can dig a hole in the ground.
- The sales period for dormant bare root plants is only in the early spring. Pick up dates and in-store sales are determined by weather and may change due to spring conditions.
- We recommend pre-ordering for guaranteed availability. Payment by means of cash, credit card or local check is required at the time of order.
- Plant availability is subject to prior sales, ability to hold stock dormant, and crop condition. Other bare root plant material not listed may be available as a special order in certain quantities.
- Items are of grade and true to type (as well as can be known). We select varieties that are best suited for our zone and growing conditions.
- We have a lot of plant information available on our website - much more detailed than the short descriptions listed on our bare root list.
- Customer pick-up is required. Delivery by our truck within the region may be arranged for a separate fee and depends on a few factors like order size. We do not ship plants via mail services.

Hanson's Garden Village's Bare Root Guarantee

Survivability of plants is GUARANTEED under the following conditions:

- We are satisfied that prudent care was provided: planted in a timely manner, watered adequately, protected from damage, etc.
- It can be demonstrated that a means of regular watering was available.
- The loss was not due to deer, rabbit, insects, acts of nature or similar damage beyond our control.
- The guarantee period includes the current growing season up to August 1st.
- We do not guarantee any plant material over the winter due to weather conditions and extremes that are out of our control.

The guarantee allows for, at your choice, one of the following remedies:

- Deduction of the bare root price paid off a similar potted tree or shrub.
- In-store credit

Dead woody plants must be uprooted and returned to us by August 1st of the year planted, with original tag attached and presentation of a receipt. Friday, July 31st, 2026 is the last day we will accept any bare root claims. NO EXCEPTIONS!

WE RECOMMEND GIVING YOUR BARE ROOT PLANT A FEW MONTHS TO GROW BEFORE UPROOTING FOR RETURN - SOME PLANTS MAY TAKE LONGER TO ESTABLISH OR BE AFFECTED BY SPRING WEATHER CONDITIONS.

IF YOU ARE UNSURE ABOUT YOUR PLANT, GIVE US A CALL BEFORE UPROOTING.

Recommendations for Planting Bare Root

Thank you for buying bare root trees and shrubs from Hanson's Garden Village, LLC. A bare root selection offers affordability, ease of transport, and great selection. Follow the instructions carefully and look forward to enjoying your plants for years to come.

- When not planted immediately, place plants in a cool, shady location and keep roots moist. We recommend planting them as soon as possible not to exceed two weeks of proper storage time.
- Soak plants in water (may be augmented with a root stimulator) for a few hours or overnight before planting. Do not let roots dry out. Do not soak for more than 24 hours.
- Dig a large enough hole so the roots of your specimen are not crowded. This would also be the time to mix in any compost or soil amendments, if needed, with the soil from the hole. Trim damaged roots, or roots that will not fit into the hole.
- Create a small mound at the bottom of the hole. Place the plant on top of the mound and spread the roots out evenly. Adjust the depth of the hole if necessary. Look for a stain line on the stem to judge planting depth.
- Back fill soil, perhaps adding a slow release fertilizer. Create a shallow basin around the stem, water and mulch. The root stimulator water used for soaking may be used to water the plant.
- Check plants regularly for water and be patient as they adjust to their new location. Some plants take a while to leaf out. Water frequently at first.
- A winter tree wrap is recommended to protect young trees from rodents and winter sun, put on in fall – remove in warm weather.

Sue's 2026 Moss Basket Classes



Don't miss out on our most popular planting class! Book your gardening therapy now!

In this class, create your own large 16" moss hanging baskets. You pick the plants based on sun or shade with Sue and crew helping along the way as needed. The hanging baskets are left to grow in our greenhouses until Memorial Day, May 25th (unless you pick them up sooner.) We can also plant your basket for you - check below for more information on this service.

Classes will be held in one hour time slots and limited to 20 people. Pre-payment is required to hold a spot in the class. Classes can fill up quickly and registration may close if we reach the maximum amount of baskets we have greenhouse space for. If you can not attend, a refund in the form of a store credit will be issued.

"Open Planting" time slots are for returning moss basket students that do not need a demonstration. Students can come at any time during this designated time frame to make their baskets. HGV crew members will be on hand for minimal assistance. This is only open to people who have taken our moss basket class before and understand the process.
