

SHADE SHRUBS

ALPINE CURRANT



- THEIR DENSE, COMPACT GROWTH HABIT MAKES THEM IDEAL FOR FORMAL OR INFORMAL HEDGES, AND THEIR ABILITY TO TOLERATE PRUNING ALLOWS FOR SHAPING AND MAINTENANCE
- THEY ALSO OFFER A RELATIVELY FINE TEXTURE THAT CAN BE PAIRED WITH COARSER-LEAVED PLANTS FOR VISUAL INTEREST
- SMALL RED BERRIES CAN ATTRACT BIRDS
- DEER RESISTANT

AZALEA



- EARLY SPRING BLOOMING DECIDUOUS SHRUBS IN MANY COLORS
- HAVE FINE, SHALLOW ROOT SYSTEMS, SO WELL-DRAINED SOIL IS IMPORTANT, PREFERS ACIDIC SOILS
- GROWS BEST IN PART SHADE, BUT TOLERATES FULL SUN
- PRUNE LIGHTLY TO REMOVE DEAD WOOD AND PROMOTE BUSHIER GROWTH
- DEER RESISTANT

CORALBERRY



- A COMPACT, DEER RESISTANT SHRUB FOR SHADE
- LOW, ROUND MOUNDED HABIT
- USEFUL AS A GROUND COVER, FOR EROSION CONTROL ON SLOPES, AS HEDGES AND BORDERS, AND FOR MASS PLANTINGS TO CREATE A VISUALLY STRIKING DISPLAY
- PINK OR WHITE BERRIES THAT PERSIST THROUGH WINTER AND ARE ENJOYED BY BIRDS
- DEER RESISTANT

COTONEASTER



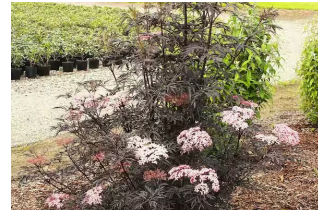
- PRIMARILY USED AS HEDGES, SCREENS, AND FOUNDATION PLANTINGS DUE TO THEIR DENSE GROWTH HABIT AND ATTRACTIVE FOLIAGE AND BERRIES
- THEY CAN ALSO BE PRUNED TO VARIOUS SHAPES AND SIZES, ADDING STRUCTURE AND VISUAL INTEREST TO LANDSCAPES
- FOLIAGE TURNS YELLOW OR RED IN THE FALL
- ATTRACTIVE BLACK FRUIT PERSISTS INTO WINTER AND ADDS VISUAL INTEREST DURING COLDER MONTHS
- CAN TOLERATE SHADE AND DROUGHT
- DEER RESISTANT

HYDRANGEA



- ARBORESCENS TYPES ARE SHADE TOLERANT
- COMMONLY PLANTED IN MASS PLANTINGS, MIXED BORDERS, WOODLAND GARDENS, AND AS SPECIMENS
- LARGE, SHOWY WHITE OR PINK BLOOMS IN LATE SUMMER
- CAN TOLERATE MOIST SOILS
- THESE TYPES CAN BE PRUNED DOWN TO THE GROUND YEARLY AFTER BLOOMING
- MUST BE PROTECTED FROM DEER

LACED UP ELDERBERRY



- A UNIQUE SHRUB WITH COLUMNAR FORM AND DARK FOLIAGE
- USEFUL AS AN ACCENT, IN MASS PLANTINGS, AS A HEDGE OR SCREEN, IN GENERAL GARDEN SETTINGS, OR EVEN IN NATURALIZED OR WOODLAND GARDENS
- ITS NARROW HABIT ALSO MAKES IT SUITABLE FOR SMALLER SPACES
- CAN TOLERATE LIGHT SHADE
- DEER RESISTANT

RHODODENDRON



- EARLY SPRING BLOOMING SHRUBS WITH PINK TO PURPLE FLOWERS
- LEATHERY, EVERGREEN LEAVES STAY ON SHRUB ALL YEAR LONG
- PREFERS MOIST, ACIDIC, ORGANIC RICH, WELL-DRAINED SOILS
- GROWS BEST IN PART TO FULL SHADE, PROTECTED FROM WINTER WINDS
- DEER RESISTANT

SNOWBERRY



- A NATIVE SHRUB GROWN FOR ITS DEER RESISTANCE, UNIQUE BERRIES AND SHADE TOLERANCE
- USEFUL FOR EROSION CONTROL
- BERRIES ARE A WILDLIFE FOOD SOURCE AND PERSIST THROUGH WINTER
- LOW MAINTENANCE
- ADAPTABLE TO VARIOUS CONDITIONS, THRIVING IN BOTH SUN AND SHADE AND TOLERATING POOR SOILS
- DEER RESISTANT

STEPHANANDRA



- PRIMARILY USED IN LANDSCAPES AS GROUNDCOVER, FOR EROSION CONTROL ON SLOPES, AND AS EDGING OR BORDER PLANTS
- LOW, SPREADING HABIT FILLS IN SPACES AND CREATES A DENSE, VISUALLY APPEALING COVER
- LOW MAINTENANCE AND EASY TO PRUNE
- TOLERATES SHADE
- ORANGE-RED FALL COLOR
- DEER RESISTANT

STRAIGHT TALK PRIVET



- USED AS A PRIVACY HEDGE, VERTICAL ACCENT, OR IN FORMAL HEDGES AND TOPIARY
- IT'S KNOWN FOR ITS DENSE, COLUMNAR GROWTH HABIT, MAKING IT AN EXCELLENT CHOICE FOR SCREENING AND CREATING A FORMAL, STRUCTURED LOOK
- LOW MAINTENANCE, TOLERATES PRUNING
- FULL SUN TO PART SHADE
- DEER RESISTANT

SUMMERSWEET



- FRAGRANT, LATE SUMMER FLOWER SPIRES IN WHITES AND PINKS
- SMALL TO MEDIUM SHRUB, DEPENDING ON VARIETY
- ATTRACTS BUTTERFLIES AND BIRDS
- YELLOW AUTUMN LEAVES, AND INTERESTING, DELICATE DRIED SEED CAPSULES IN WINTER
- GROWS BEST IN PART SHADE TO FULL SUN IN MOIST TO WET SOILS
- DEER RESISTANT

WEIGELA



- USEFUL AS HEDGES, BORDERS, FOUNDATION PLANTINGS, AND ACCENT PIECES
- THEY ARE POPULAR FOR THEIR ATTRACTIVE, COLORFUL PINK OR RED BLOOMS, VIBRANT FOLIAGE AND ABILITY TO ATTRACT HUMMINGBIRDS AND OTHER POLLINATORS
- FOLIAGE COLORS VARY BY VARIETY
- TOLERATES SHADE
- DEER RESISTANT

SUN SHRUBS

BUTTONBUSH



- WHITE PINCUSHION-SHAPED FRAGRANT FLOWERS, WHICH BLOOM THROUGHOUT LATE SUMMER
- A NATIVE PLANT THAT GROWS BEST IN FULL SUN TO PART SHADE AND MOIST TO WET AREAS
- ATTRACTS BUTTERFLIES AND BEES
- MEDIUM TO LARGE GROWING SHRUB
- LOW-MAINTENANCE PLANT
- RED FRUIT IN THE WINTER
- DEER RESISTANT

DOGWOOD



- BOTH NATIVE AND CULTIVAR VARIETIES AVAILABLE
- SHRUBS GROW FAST AND PREFER MOIST AREAS
- USEFUL IN SCREENING AND PRIVACY BARRIERS
- MANY HAVE COLORFUL STEMS WHICH ADD VISUAL INTEREST IN THE WINTER
- LEAF COLORS VARY BY VARIETY
- FLOWERS AND BERRIES ATTRACT BIRDS AND POLLINATORS
- CAN HELP WITH SOIL STABILIZATION IN EROSION-PRONE AREAS

DWARF BURNING BUSH



- COMPACT, MOUNDED SHAPE
- NON-INVASIVE BURNING BUSH
- HARDY AND LOW MAINTENANCE
- GREEN LEAVES DURING GROWING SEASON THAT TURN BRIGHT RED IN THE FALL
- HANDLES PRUNING WELL
- 5-4' TALL, 5-8' WIDE
- MODERATELY DEER RESISTANT

FINE LINE BUCKTHORN



- THEIR UNIQUE, UPRIGHT, AND NARROW FORM, COMBINED WITH FINELY TEXTURED FOLIAGE, MAKES THEM SUITABLE FOR VARIOUS APPLICATIONS WHERE SPACE IS LIMITED
- USED IN LANDSCAPES FOR NARROW HEDGES, SCREENS, OR AS SPECIMEN PLANTS
- CAN BE PLANTED IN WELL-DRAINED SOILS FROM FULL SUN TO PART SHADE
- DEER RESISTANT

FORSYTHIA



- ONE OF THE FIRST PLANTS TO BLOOM IN THE SPRING
- BRIGHT YELLOW FLOWERS, PRUNE AFTER IT BLOOMS
- FLOWER STEMS CAN BE USED IN CUT FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS
- LOW MAINTENANCE
- MEDIUM TO TALL SHRUB, DEPENDING ON VARIETY
- PREFERS FULL SUN AND WELL-DRAINED SOIL
- DEER RESISTANT

GRO-LOW SUMAC



- A POPULAR SHRUB FOR ITS LOW, SPREADING HABIT (2-3' TALL, 6-8' WIDE) MAKES THEM IDEAL FOR MASS PLANTINGS, STABILIZING SLOPES, AND CREATING DENSE, WEED-SUPPRESSING COVERAGE
- ATTRACTIVE FALL FOLIAGE COLOR AND FRAGRANT LEAVES
- ATTRACTS BUTTERFLIES AND BIRDS, AND A HOST PLANT FOR SOME MOTH AND BUTTERFLY SPECIES
- MODERATELY DEER RESISTANT

HYDRANGEA



- PANICULATA TYPES GROW BEST IN OUR REGION
- POPULAR BLOOMS WITH LARGE ROUNDED OR CONICAL FLOWERS FROM JULY TO SEPTEMBER IN WHITES, PINKS AND/OR REDS
- VARIETY OF HEIGHTS FROM 3' TO 8'
- PREFERS FULL SUN TO PART SUN, CONSISTENT MOISTURE & WELL DRAINED SOILS
- BENEFIT FROM ANNUAL PRUNING
- MUST BE PROTECTED FROM DEER

HYPERICUM COBALT 'N GOLD



- FUNCTIONS WELL AS BORDER PLANTINGS, FOUNDATION PLANTINGS, GROUNDCOVER, AND IN NATURALIZED AREAS
- FINE BLUE-GREEN FOLIAGE AND YELLOW FLOWERS IN SUMMER
- COMPACT SIZE
- ATTRACTS POLLINATORS
- YELLOW, ORANGE TO RED FALL FOLIAGE COLOR
- DEER RESISTANT

ICEBERG ALLEY SAGELEAF WILLOW



- USED IN LANDSCAPES FOR ITS SILVERY FOLIAGE, ATTRACTIVE CATKINS, AND ABILITY TO THRIVE IN VARIOUS CONDITIONS
- USEFUL IN MASS PLANTINGS, LOW HEDGES, RAIN GARDENS, AS A BACKDROP IN MIXED BORDERS AND AS A SPECIMEN PLANT
- ADAPTABLE TO MOIST SOILS
- COLD HARDY
- DEER RESISTANT

JADE PARADE SAND CHERRY



- IT'S OFTEN USED FOR MASS PLANTINGS, GENERAL GARDEN USE, NATURALIZING, AND EVEN EDIBLE LANDSCAPING
- HAS A LOW, SPREADING HABIT (2-4 FEET TALL AND SPREADING 6-8 FEET WIDE) IDEAL FOR A GROUNDCOVER EFFECT WITH DENSE GROWTH THAT HELPS SUPPRESS WEEDS AND ADDS TEXTURE TO THE LANDSCAPE
- LOW MAINTENANCE AND DROUGHT TOLERANT
- EXTENSIVE ROOT SYSTEM GOOD FOR EROSION CONTROL
- ATTRACTIVE FOLIAGE AND FLOWERS
- SMALL BLACK FRUIT IS EDIBLE TO PEOPLE AND WILDLIFE

LILAC



- KNOWN FOR THEIR FRAGRANT CLUSTERS OF FLOWERS, TYPICALLY IN SHADES OF PURPLE, PINK, AND WHITE
- BLOOMS IN SPRING
- DEPENDING ON VARIETY, HEIGHTS FROM 4' TO 15'
- GROW BEST IN FULL SUN & WELL-DRAINED SOIL
- PRUNE AFTER THEY FINISH FLOWERING IN SPRING
- MUST BE PROTECTED FROM DEER

LOTUS MOON PEARLBUSH



- A COMPACT AND MOUNDED, UPRIGHT SHRUB WITH PROFUSE BRIGHT WHITE SPRING FLOWERS
- FLOWER BUDS LOOK LIKE STRINGS OF PEARLS
- LOW MAINTENANCE
- USEFUL AS FOCAL POINTS, FOUNDATION PLANTINGS, MIXED BORDERS, MASS PLANTINGS OR INFORMAL HEDGES
- ATTRACTS BEES AND BUTTERFLIES
- DEER RESISTANT

MOCKORANGE



- FRAGRANT, WHITE, ORANGE-BLOSSOM-LIKE FLOWERS IN LATE SPRING MAKE THEM A POPULAR CHOICE FOR ADDING BEAUTY AND SCENT TO OUTDOOR SPACES
- USEFUL AS FOCAL POINTS, IN MIXED BORDERS, HEDGES, FOUNDATION PLANTINGS, AND WILDLIFE GARDENS
- MODERATELY DEER RESISTANT

NINEBARK



- MANY UNIQUE CULTIVARS AND NATIVE VARIETIES
- USEFUL FOR PRIVACY SCREENS AND HEDGES TO FOCAL POINTS AND WILDLIFE ATTRACTANTS
- POPULAR DUE TO ATTRACTIVE FOLIAGE, FLOWERS, AND BARK FOR YEAR-ROUND INTEREST
- FOLIAGE COLORS VARY FROM GREEN, ORANGE, YELLOW OR PURPLE DEPENDING ON VARIETY
- ADAPTABLE TO DIFFERENT CONDITIONS

POTENTILLA



- HARDY, LONG BLOOMING SHRUB IN SHADES OF YELLOW, ORANGE, PINK OR WHITE FROM SUMMER TO FALL
- DURABLE, COMPACT GROWERS FOR TOUGH SPOTS
- LOW MAINTENANCE, EASY TO PRUNE AND SHAPE
- PREFER FULL SUN BUT WILL HANDLE LIGHT SHADE & WELL-DRAINED SOIL
- DEER RESISTANT

PURPLE LEAF SAND CHERRY



- STRIKING REDDISH-PURPLE FOLIAGE AND FRAGRANT PINKISH-WHITE FLOWERS
- USED AS COLORFUL ACCENTS, HEDGES, SCREENS AND FOR MIXED BORDERS
- YEAR-ROUND VISUAL INTEREST
- EASILY PRUNED OR SHAPED
- ATTRACTS POLLINATORS LIKE BEES AND BUTTERFLIES
- SMALL, DARK-COLORED FRUIT IS GREAT FOR BIRDS
- 8-10' TALL AND WIDE

SHRUB ROSE



- THEY CAN SERVE AS INFORMAL HEDGES, BORDERS, MASS PLANTINGS, OR AS A GROUNDCOVER
- OFFER CONTINUOUS FRAGRANT BLOOMS THROUGHOUT THE SEASON
- LOW MAINTENANCE
- WINTER HARDY, NEEDING NO EXTRA PROTECTION
- ATTRACTS POLLINATORS
- PREFERS FULL SUN AND WELL DRAINED SOIL

SPIREA



- EASY TO GROW, LOW MAINTENANCE, DEPENDABLE & VERSATILE
- FLOWERS IN SPRING OR SUMMER IN PINKS OR WHITES
- VARIETY OF SHAPES AND SIZES, ALTHOUGH TYPICALLY A COMPACT GROWER
- DROUGHT TOLERANT
- ATTRACTS POLLINATORS
- RESILIENT TO PRUNING
- RELATIVELY DEER RESISTANT

TIGER EYES SUMAC



- A SHRUB WITH VIBRANT CHARTREUSE TOOTHED FOLIAGE AND INTERESTING FORM
- IT CAN BE USED AS AN ACCENT PLANT, MASS PLANTING, IN BORDERS, OR FOR CREATING A UNIQUE HEDGE OR SCREEN
- ORANGE AND SCARLET FOLIAGE IN THE FALL
- MODERATELY DEER RESISTANT

WILLOW



- DIFFERENT CULTIVAR TYPES AND NATIVE VARIETIES
- USEFUL AS SCREENS, FOCAL POINTS, AND PROVIDING YEAR-ROUND INTEREST WITH THEIR COLORFUL STEMS AND UNIQUE NARROW FOLIAGE
- THEY ARE VALUABLE FOR EROSION CONTROL, SUPPORTING WILDLIFE, AND ADDING TEXTURE TO THE LANDSCAPE
- TOLERATES WET CONDITIONS
- DEER RESISTANT

VIBURNUM



- MANY UNIQUE CULTIVARS AND NATIVE VARIETIES
- USEFUL FOR PRIVACY SCREENS TO FOUNDATION PLANTINGS, AND EVEN AS SPECIMEN PLANTS
- ADAPTABLE TO DIFFERENT SOIL TYPES AND CLIMATES
- MULTI-SEASONAL APPEAL WITH ATTRACTIVE FLOWERS, FOLIAGE, AND BERRIES
- BENEFICIAL TO WILDLIFE, ATTRACTING POLLINATORS WITH THEIR FLOWERS AND PROVIDING FOOD FOR BIRDS WITH THEIR BERRIES

VINING SHRUBS

HONEYSUCKLE VINE



- USED FOR CREATING VISUALLY APPEALING SCREENS, ADDING VERTICAL INTEREST ON TRELLISES, ARBORS, AND FENCES, OR AS A GROUND COVER
- HONEYSUCKLE FLOWERS ATTRACT HUMMINGBIRDS, BUTTERFLIES, AND OTHER POLLINATORS
- FULL SUN TO PART SHADE AND WELL DRAINED SOIL
- REGULAR PRUNING MAY BE NEEDED TO CONTROL THEIR GROWTH
- DEER RESISTANT

AUTUMN REVOLUTION BITTERWSEET VINE



- A VIGOROUS VINE THAT CAN GROW QUICKLY AND SPREAD
- PROVIDE IT WITH A STURDY SUPPORT STRUCTURE AND BE PREPARED TO MANAGE ITS GROWTH
- USEFUL TO COVER FENCES, ARBORS, TRELLISES, AND OTHER STRUCTURES, OR EVEN AS A GROUNDCOVER
- SHOWY ORANGE AND RED BERRIES ARE A FOOD SOURCE FOR BIRDS IN THE FALL AND WINTER
- VIBRANT FALL COLOR
- CAN BE USED IN DRIED FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS
- DEER RESISTANT

ENGELMAN IVY VINE



- A SELF-CLINGING VINE USEFUL FOR COVERING WALLS, FENCES, AND AS GROUNDCOVER
- VIGOROUS GROWER CAN BE PRUNED AS NEEDED
- KNOWN FOR ITS HARDINESS, TOLERATING SALT, DROUGHT, FLOOD, AND COLD TEMPERATURES
- GROWS IN FULL SUN TO FULL SHADE
- ORANGE-RED FALL COLOR AND SMALL BLUE BERRIES FOR BIRDS
- DEER RESISTANT

NATIVE SHRUBS

AMERICAN HAZELNUT



- ADAPTABLE NATIVE SHRUB
- 8-12' TALL
- THEY ARE EXCELLENT FOR HEDGES AND PRIVACY SCREENS, CAN BE USED IN WOODLAND GARDENS, AND ARE GREAT FOR EDIBLE LANDSCAPING,
- THE NUTS ARE EDIBLE AND CAN BE HARVESTED FOR PERSONAL USE OR TO ATTRACT WILDLIFE
- TOLERATES SHADY AND SANDY CONDITIONS
- MODERATELY DEER RESISTANT

AMERICAN HAZELNUT



- ADAPTABLE NATIVE SHRUB
- 8-12' TALL
- THEY ARE EXCELLENT FOR HEDGES AND PRIVACY SCREENS, CAN BE USED IN WOODLAND GARDENS, AND ARE GREAT FOR EDIBLE LANDSCAPING,
- THE NUTS ARE EDIBLE AND CAN BE HARVESTED FOR PERSONAL USE OR TO ATTRACT WILDLIFE
- TOLERATES SHADY AND SANDY CONDITIONS
- MODERATELY DEER RESISTANT

BLADDERNUT



- USEFUL FOR NATURALIZED AREAS, SCREENING, AND EROSION CONTROL
- THRIVE IN MOIST, WELL-DRAINED SOILS AND CAN TOLERATE SHADE
- UNIQUE FEATURES, LIKE THE WHITE BELL-SHAPED FLOWERS AND INFLATED SEED PODS ADD VISUAL INTEREST THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.
- UP TO 15' TALL

CRANBERRYBUSH



- AVAILABLE AS A COMPACT CULTIVAR OR TALLER NATIVE TYPES
- USEFUL FOR BORDERS, SCREENS, MASS PLANTINGS, AND AS SPECIMEN PLANTS
- THEY OFFER VISUAL INTEREST WITH WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, BRIGHT RED BERRIES, AND ATTRACTIVE FALL FOLIAGE
- THEY PROVIDE FOOD AND SHELTER FOR WILDLIFE, ATTRACTING BIRDS AND OTHER ANIMALS
- CAN TOLERATE A RANGE OF CONDITIONS AND ARE SUITABLE FOR PLANTING IN AREAS WHERE OTHER PLANTS MAY STRUGGLE

DOGWOOD



- BOTH NATIVE AND CULTIVAR VARIETIES AVAILABLE
- SHRUBS GROW FAST AND PREFER MOIST AREAS
- USEFUL IN SCREENING AND PRIVACY BARRIERS
- MANY HAVE COLORFUL STEMS WHICH ADD VISUAL INTEREST IN THE WINTER
- LEAF COLORS VARY BY VARIETY
- FLOWERS AND BERRIES ATTRACT BIRDS AND POLLINATORS
- CAN HELP WITH SOIL STABILIZATION IN EROSION-PRONE AREAS

PAGODA DOGWOOD



- USED AS SPECIMEN TREES, SHRUB BORDERS OR FOR NATURALIZING IN WOODLAND AREAS
- UNIQUE HORIZONTAL BRANCHING PATTERN CREATES ARCHITECTURAL INTEREST AND FOCAL POINTS
- 15-25' TALL AND WIDE
- PROVIDES FOOD AND HABITAT FOR BIRDS AND POLLINATORS
- WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, BLUE BERRIES, FALL COLOR
- BEST IN PART-SHADE WITH COOL, MOIST SOIL
- IT CAN TOLERATE FULL SUN PROVIDED MOISTURE AND MULCH ARE MAINTAINED TO KEEP THE ROOTS COOL

DWARF BUSH HONEYSUCKLE



- NATIVE, LOW GROWING SHRUB WITH BRIGHT YELLOW FLOWERS THAT ATTRACT POLLINATORS AND HUMMINGBIRDS
- EXCELLENT FOR MASS PLANTINGS, BORDERS, AND EROSION CONTROL, ESPECIALLY ON SLOPES
- THEIR ABILITY TO SPREAD VIA SUCKERS ALSO MAKES THEM USEFUL FOR CREATING NATURALIZED AREAS OR HEDGES
- THEY TOLERATE A VARIETY OF CONDITIONS, INCLUDING DRY SHADE AND URBAN ENVIRONMENTS
- BEAUTIFUL RED FALL COLOR
- 3-4' TALL AND WIDE

GLOSSY BLACK CHOKEBERRY



- BOTH NATIVE AND CULTIVAR SHRUB TYPES
- PRIZED FOR ITS EDIBLE HIGH ANTIOXIDANT FRUITS
- WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, RED FALL FOLIAGE
- 3-6' TALL
- TOLERANT OF WET OR DRY CONDITIONS
- SUN TO PART SHADE
- FLOWERS ATTRACT POLLINATORS, BERRIES PROVIDE FOOD FOR BIRDS AND OTHER WILDLIFE
- GOOD FOR EROSION CONTROL & NATIVE PLANTINGS

GLOSSY BLACK CHOKEBERRY



- BOTH NATIVE AND CULTIVAR SHRUB TYPES
- PRIZED FOR ITS EDIBLE HIGH ANTIOXIDANT FRUITS
- WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, RED FALL FOLIAGE
- 3-6' TALL
- TOLERANT OF WET OR DRY CONDITIONS
- SUN TO PART SHADE
- FLOWERS ATTRACT POLLINATORS, BERRIES PROVIDE FOOD FOR BIRDS AND OTHER WILDLIFE
- GOOD FOR EROSION CONTROL & NATIVE PLANTINGS

DOWNY ARROWWOOD VIBURNUM

- VERSATILE NATIVE SHRUB USEFUL FOR BORDERS, HEDGES, NATURALIZING AND WOODLAND GARDENS
- GOOD FOR POLLINATORS AND EROSION CONTROL
- 5-8' TALL
- WHITE FLOWERS IN SPRING, BLUE-BLACK BERRIES IN LATE SUMMER, AND VIBRANT RED FALL FOLIAGE
- LOW MAINTENANCE AND DROUGHT TOLERANT
- FULL SUN TO PART SHADE

SERVICEBERRY



- ALSO CALLED JUNE BERRIES OR SASKATOON BERRIES, SEVERAL SPECIES ARE NATIVE TO WISCONSIN
- CAN BE A LARGE SHRUB OR SMALL TREE
- YEAR-ROUND INTEREST WITH WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, YELLOW TO RED FALL FOLIAGE, SMOOTH GRAY BARK, AND EDIBLE PURPLE FRUIT
- ATTRACTS BIRDS, POLLINATORS AND WILDLIFE

DOWNY SERVICEBERRY



- TALL, NATIVE SHRUB USED FOR THE ORNAMENTAL VALUE AND AS A FOOD SOURCE FOR WILDLIFE AND POLLINATORS
- BEAUTIFUL WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, EDIBLE BERRIES THAT ATTRACT BIRDS, AND VIBRANT FALL FOLIAGE IN SHADES OF YELLOW, ORANGE, AND RED
- 15-25' TALL
- ADAPTABLE TO MANY SOIL TYPES
- FULL SUN TO PART SHADE

NANNYBERRY VIBURNUM



- NATIVE SHRUB OFTEN PLANTED AS HEDGES, SCREENS, OR WINDBREAKS DUE TO THEIR UPRIGHT GROWTH HABIT AND ABILITY TO FORM DENSE THICKETS
- USEFUL IN MASS PLANTINGS, NATURALIZING AREAS, OR AS ACCENT PLANTS IN A GARDEN
- WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, EDIBLE BERRIES AND VIBRANT FALL FOLIAGE
- ADAPTABLE TO BOTH WET AND DRY CONDITIONS
- GOOD SOURCE OF FOOD AND SHELTER FOR WILDLIFE
- DEER RESISTANT

VIBURNUM



- MANY UNIQUE CULTIVARS AND NATIVE VARIETIES
- USEFUL FOR PRIVACY SCREENS TO FOUNDATION PLANTINGS, AND EVEN AS SPECIMEN PLANTS
- ADAPTABLE TO DIFFERENT SOIL TYPES AND CLIMATES
- MULTI-SEASONAL APPEAL WITH ATTRACTIVE FLOWERS, FOLIAGE, AND BERRIES
- BENEFICIAL TO WILDLIFE, ATTRACTING POLLINATORS WITH THEIR FLOWERS AND PROVIDING FOOD FOR BIRDS WITH THEIR BERRIES

WESTERN SAND CHERRY



- ADAPTABLE NATIVE SHRUB
- LOW MAINTENANCE, THRIVES IN POOR SOILS
- WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, GREEN LEAVES AND VIBRANT RED FALL FOLIAGE
- CAN BE USED AS A BORDER, HEDGE, OR BARRIER PLANT, THANKS TO ITS SUCKERING HABIT AND ABILITY TO FORM DENSE THICKETS
- IT ALSO SERVES WELL AS A SPECIMEN PLANT, IN MASS PLANTINGS, OR AS EROSION CONTROL ON SLOPES
- THE CHERRIES ATTRACT BIRDS AND OTHER ANIMALS, AND IT PROVIDES NESTING COVER

WILLOW



- DIFFERENT CULTIVAR TYPES AND NATIVE VARIETIES
- USEFUL AS SCREENS, FOCAL POINTS, AND PROVIDING YEAR-ROUND INTEREST WITH THEIR COLORFUL STEMS AND UNIQUE NARROW FOLIAGE
- THEY ARE VALUABLE FOR EROSION CONTROL, SUPPORTING WILDLIFE, AND ADDING TEXTURE TO THE LANDSCAPE
- TOLERATES WET CONDITIONS
- DEER RESISTANT

WINTERBERRY



- A NATIVE SHRUB GROWN FOR ITS COLORFUL FRUIT
- NEEDS MALE AND FEMALE VARIETIES TO PRODUCE BERRIES WHICH BENEFIT WILDLIFE
- GROWS WILD IN ACIDIC SOILS IN FORESTED WETLANDS OR ALONG EDGES OF PONDS, LAKES AND MARSHES
- FULL SUN TO PART SHADE
- DEER RESISTANT

SNOWBERRY



- A NATIVE SHRUB GROWN FOR ITS DEER RESISTANCE, UNIQUE BERRIES AND SHADE TOLERANCE
- USEFUL FOR EROSION CONTROL
- BERRIES ARE A WILDLIFE FOOD SOURCE AND PERSIST THROUGH WINTER
- LOW MAINTENANCE
- ADAPTABLE TO VARIOUS CONDITIONS, THRIVING IN BOTH SUN AND SHADE AND TOLERATING POOR SOILS
- DEER RESISTANT

FRUIT SHRUBS

BLUEBERRY



- SHRUB GROWN FOR EDIBLE BERRIES
- HEIGHTS AND FRUIT VARY BY VARIETY
- SELF-FRUITFUL, HOWEVER, TWO OR MORE CULTIVARS PRODUCE LARGER FRUIT THAT RIPENS EARLIER
- REQUIRE A UNIFORMLY MOIST, ACIDIC SOIL FOR BEST RESULTS (AMEND WITH SOIL SULFUR IN SPRING)
- BRILLIANT FALL COLORS
- FULL SUN TO PART SUN

GRAPE



- CLASSIFIED AS EITHER TABLE (EATEN RAW) OR WINE
- TABLE GRAPES TEND TO HAVE LARGE, SEEDLESS FRUIT WITH RELATIVELY THIN SKIN WHICH MAKE IT EASIER FOR SNACKING AND MAKING JAMS, JELLIES, AND JUICES
- WINE GRAPES ARE VERY SWEET SMALLER, USUALLY SEEDED, AND HAVE RELATIVELY THICK SKINS WHICH MUCH OF THE WINES AROMA COMES FROM
- NEEDS A SUPPORTING STRUCTURE TO GROW
- FULL SUN

GLOSSY BLACK CHOKEBERRY



- BOTH NATIVE AND CULTIVAR SHRUB TYPES
- PRIZED FOR ITS EDIBLE HIGH ANTIOXIDANT FRUITS
- WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, RED FALL FOLIAGE
- TOLERANT OF WET OR DRY CONDITIONS
- FLOWERS ATTRACT BEES AND OTHER POLLINATORS, WHILE THE BERRIES PROVIDE FOOD FOR BIRDS AND OTHER WILDLIFE
- ALSO GOOD FOR EROSION CONTROL, NATIVE PLANTINGS AND EDIBLE GARDENING

CRANBERRYBUSH



- AVAILABLE AS A COMPACT CULTIVAR OR TALLER NATIVE TYPES
- USEFUL FOR BORDERS, SCREENS, MASS PLANTINGS, AND AS SPECIMEN PLANTS
- THEY OFFER VISUAL INTEREST WITH WHITE SPRING FLOWERS, BRIGHT RED BERRIES, AND ATTRACTIVE FALL FOLIAGE
- THEY PROVIDE FOOD AND SHELTER FOR WILDLIFE, ATTRACTING BIRDS AND OTHER ANIMALS
- CAN TOLERATE A RANGE OF CONDITIONS AND ARE SUITABLE FOR PLANTING IN AREAS WHERE OTHER PLANTS MAY STRUGGLE

HONEYBERRY



- PRODUCE SMALL, BLUE, ELONGATED BERRIES WITH A TASTE OFTEN DESCRIBED AS A MIX OF BLUEBERRY AND RASPBERRY WITH A ZING, SURPASSING THE ANTIOXIDANTS OF BLUEBERRIES
- EAT THEM FRESH, BAKE OR MAKE INTO JAMS
- REQUIRE TWO OR MORE VARIETIES FOR POLLINATION
- LOW MAINTENANCE
- THRIVE IN FULL SUN TO PART SHADE AND PREFER WELL-DRAINED SOIL, BUT ARE ADAPTABLE

RASPBERRY



- SHRUB GROWN FOR THE EDIBLE FRUITS
- RASPBERRIES CAN BE EATEN FRESH, MAKE GREAT JAMS, JELLIES AND DESSERTS
- SELF-POLLINATING BUT MULTIPLE VARIETIES CAN INCREASE FRUIT PRODUCTION
- WELL-DRAINED, SANDY LOAM SOIL RICH IN ORGANIC MATTER IS IDEAL
- FULL SUN (6-8 HOURS DAILY)

BLACK ELDERBERRY



- NATIVE SHRUB
- UP TO 12' TALL & WIDE
- GOOD FOR HEDGES, PRIVACY SCREENS, WILDLIFE & POLLINATOR ATTRACTORS, EDIBLE LANDSCAPES AND EROSION CONTROL
- ATTRACTIVE FLOWERS AND BERRIES
- FULL SUN TO PART SHADE
- MODERATE SOIL CONDITIONS

JOSTABERRY



- BERRY FLAVOR IS A CROSS BETWEEN BLACK CURRANT AND GOOSEBERRY
- SELF-FRUITFUL
- HIGH IN ANTIOXIDANTS
- 3-6' TALL AND WIDE
- LOAMY TO SANDY WELL-DRAINED SOIL
- FULL SUN (6-8 HOURS DAILY) TO PART SUN
- COLD HARDY, ZONES 3-8
